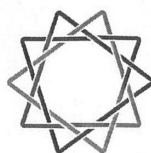

Application form for a Cecil King Travel Scholarship 2023 Award

Personal details

The LMS administers two £6000 travel awards funded by The Cecil King Memorial Foundation for early career mathematicians, to support a period of study or research abroad, typically for a period of 3 months. One Scholarship will be awarded to a mathematician in any area of mathematics and one to a mathematician whose research is applied in a discipline other than mathematics.

The LMS encourages applications from groups under-represented in UK mathematics, including from women, disabled, Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic mathematicians.

Eligibility Criteria and How to Apply

Applicants should be mathematicians registered for a doctorate degree in the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland or have completed such a degree within 12 months of the closing date for applications.

The application should include a written proposal describing the intended programme of study or research abroad and the benefits to be gained from such a visit. A shortlist of applicants will be selected for interview. Candidates will be asked to give a brief presentation at the interview stage.

Candidates are asked to complete the application form and to provide:

- A CV, maximum of two sides of A4, including research interests and activities.
- A short proposal (three pages maximum). This should describe the proposed programme of study abroad (and the institution to be visited), and the benefit that the visit will bring.
- Two academic references (should be sent directly by your referees to fellowships@lms.ac.uk by the closing date).
- A letter of support from the supervisor at the institution where the proposed visit will take place.

The application form should be submitted by the closing date on 15th November 2022.

Interview

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to an online interview in January 2023 during which they will be expected to make a short (10-15 minute) presentation on their proposal, followed by 15-20 minutes for questions.

- how they expect that the visit would be of benefit to the applicant.
- that any bench fees will be waived.

This supporting statement should be no longer than one side of A4.

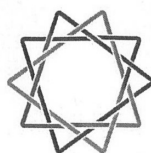
